PERAWAT DI INSTALASI GAWAT DARURAT PUSKESMAS  
KARANGNUNGGAL KABUPATEN TASIKMALAYA**

**ABSTRAK**

*Initial assessment* merupakan salah satu penerapan sistem manajemen risiko di IGD sehingga pasien yang datang mendapatkan penanganan dengan cepat dan tepat sesuai kebutuhannya dengan menggunakan sumber daya yang tersedia. Keterampilan perawat IGD sangat dibutuhkan dalam pengambilan keputusan klinis agar tidak terjadi kesalahan dalam melakukan *initial assessment* sehingga dalam penanganan pasien bisa lebih optimal dan terarah. Tujuan penelitian untuk mengetahui gambaran pelaksanaan *initial assessment* oleh perawat di Instalasi Gawat Darurat Puskesmas Karangnunggal Kabupaten Tasikmalaya. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif. Pengambilan sampel *total sampling* dengan jumlah sampel 12 orang. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa Dewasa Muda 83,3%, lama bekerja 6-10 tahun 58,3%, tingkat pendidikan DIII 66,7%. Usia dewasa muda yang melakukan *initial assessment* sebanyak 5 orang (50%), dan usia dewasa madya yang melakukan *initial assessment* sebanyak 2 orang (100%). lama bekerja 1-5 tahun dengan tidak melakukan *initial assessment* sebanyak 3 orang (60%). lama bekerja 6-10 tahun dengan *initial assessment* dilakukan sebanyak 5 orang (71,4%). Pendidikan DIII dengan *initial assessment* dilakukan sebanyak 4 orang (50%) pendidikan SI dengan *initial assessment* dilakukan sebanyak 3 orang (75%). Pelaksanaan *initial assessment* oleh perawat di Instalasi Gawat Darurat Puskesmas Karangnunggal Kabupaten Tasikmalaya dengan rata-rata 92,73. Berdasar hasil tersebut diharapkan perawat dapat memberikan asuhan keperawatan yang berkualitas dengan lebih aktif lagi dalam meningkatkan pengetahuan tentang penatalaksanaan *initial assessment* dengan mengikuti pelatihan-pelatihan, seminar dan simposium yang diselenggarakan oleh lembaga/instansi terkait.

**ABSTRACT**

Initial assessment is one of the implementation of risk management system in IGD so that patients who come get handling quickly and accurately according to their needs by using the available resources. IGD nurse skills are urgently needed in clinical decision making to avoid errors in conducting initial assessment so that in the handling of patients can be more optimal and directed. The purpose of this research is to know the description of the initial assessment by nurses at Emergency Installation Karangnunggal Health Center of Tasikmalaya. This research uses descriptive method. Sampling total sampling with sample size 12 people. The results showed that young adults 83.3%, long working 6-10 years 58.3%, education level DIII 66.7%. Young adult age who conducted initial assessment as many as 5 people (50%), and middle age who do initial assessment as much as 2 people (100%). long working 1-5 years with no initial assessment as much as 3 people (60%). length of work 6-10 years with initial assessment conducted as many as 5 people (71,4%). DIII education with initial assessment conducted as many as 4 people (50%) SI education with initial assessment conducted as many as 3 people (75%). Implementation of initial assessment by nurses at the Emergency Installation Karangnunggal Health Center of Tasikmalaya with an average of 92.73. Based on these results, it is expected that nurses can provide quality nursing care more actively in improving knowledge about initial assessment management by participating in trainings, seminars and symposium organized by related institutions / institutions.
