**FAKTOR-FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN PELAKSANAAN  
MANAJEMEN TERPADU BALITA SAKIT (MTBS) OLEH TENAGA  
KESEHATAN DI KOTA TASIKMALAYA**

**ABSTRAK**

MTBS merupakan suatu manajemen melalui pendekatan terintegrasi/terpadu dalam tatalaksana balita sakit yang datang di pelayanan kesehatan, baik mengenai beberapa klasifikasi penyakit, status MTBS, status imunisasi maupun penanganan balita sakit tersebut dan konseling yang diberikan. Konsep MTBS merupakan suatu pendekatan untuk menyiapkan petugas kesehatan melakukan penilaian, membuat klasifikasi, serta memberikan tindakan kepada anak terhadap penyakit-penyakit yang umumnya mengancam jiwa. Ada beberapa faktor yang berhubungan dengan pelaksanaan MTBS yaitu pengetahuan, sikap, dan motivasi. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan pelaksanaan Manajemen Terpadu Balita Sakit (MTBS) oleh tenaga kesehatan di Kota Tasikmalaya. Metode penelitian deskriptif kuantitatif dengan rancangan *cross sectional* dan populasi seluruh tenaga kesehatan yang merupakan pemegang program MTBS di lima puskesmas Kota Tasikmalaya sebanyak 30 orang dengan teknik total sampling. Hasil didapatkan pengetahuan sebagian besar kurang (53,3%), sikap tenaga kesehatan sebagian besar negatif (60%), motivasi tenaga kesehatan sebagian besar rendah (63,3%), dan pelaksanaan MTBS sebagian besar responden tidak melaksanakan MTBS (56,7%). Ada hubungan pengetahuan dan sikap tenaga kesehatan dengan pelaksanaan Manajemen Terpadu Balita Sakit (MTBS) oleh tenaga kesehatan di Kota Tasikmalaya, sedangkan motivasi tidak ada hubungan. Disarankan bagi petugas kesehatan yang telah dilatih MTBS, demi meningkatkan mutu pelayanan dasar kepada masyarakat khususnya balita sakit agar memanfaatkan ilmu yang didapat dengan menerapkan MTBS sesuai pedoman.

**FACTORS RELATED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INTEGRATED  
MANAGEMENT OF ILLNESS CHILDREN (MTBS) BY HEALTH  
PERSONNEL IN THE CITY OF TASIKMALAYA**

**ABSTRACT**

MTBS is a management through an integrated/integrated approach in the management of sick toddlers who come to health services, both regarding several classifications of diseases, MTBS status, immunization status as well as the handling of these sick toddlers and the counseling provided. The MTS concept is an approach to prepare health workers to carry out assessments, classify, and provide treatment for children against diseases that are generally life-threatening. There are several factors related to the implementation of MTBS, namely knowledge, attitudes, and motivation. This study aims to analyze the factors related to the implementation of Integrated Management of Sick Toddlers (MTBS) by health workers in the City of Tasikmalaya. Quantitative descriptive research method with a cross-sectional design and a population of all health workers who are holders of the MTBS program in five health centers in Tasikmalaya City as many as 30 people with a total sampling technique. The results showed that most of the knowledge was lacking (53.3%), the attitude of the health workers was mostly negative (60%), the motivation of the health workers was mostly low (63.3%), and the implementation of MTBS most of the respondents did not carry out MTBS (56.7 %). There is a relationship between the knowledge and attitudes of health workers and the implementation of Integrated Management of Sick Toddlers (IMCI) by health workers in Tasikmalaya City, while motivation has no relationship. It is recommended for health workers who have been trained in MTBS, in order to improve the quality of basic services to the community, especially sick toddlers, to take advantage of the knowledge gained by implementing MTBS according to the guidelines.
